ORDINANCE NO. 2014-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2010-01, SECTION 1 (a) ENTITLED "MIMIMUM WATER AND SEWER RATE SCHEDULES" ESTABLISHING NEW WATER AND SEWER RATES FOR THE CITY OF BULL SHOALS, ARKANSAS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bull Shoals, Arkansas previously passed Ordinance 2010-01, which Ordinance established respective schedules for water and sewer rates and penalties charges in connection with services relating thereto; and;

WHEREAS, the City must collect revenues to satisfy any and all indebtedness relating to the operation and maintenance of the water and sewer system and to satisfy bonds and loans incurred in the construction and establishment of the city water and sewer system as well as provide future repair, maintenance and improvements, and,

WHEREAS, due to the increase in the operating expense of water and the costs of disposal of sewage, the City Council desires to establish new water and sewer rates for the City of Bull Shoals, Arkansas

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BULL SHOALS, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION ONE; That the following monthly rates and charges which the City Council hereby finds and declares are fair, reasonable and necessary shall be as follows:
