ORDINANCE NO. <u>2017-0</u>7

AMENDED ORDINANCE VACATING AND ABANDONING CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF BULL SHOALS

WHEREAS, certain streets hereinafter described within the City of Bull Shoals, Arkansas, are no longer required for corporation purposes and same should be abandoned and closed as hereinafter set out;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BULL SHOALS, ARKANSAS:

THAT Ordinance No. 43, passed and approved February 22, 1972, contained certain scrivener errors of street names.

WHEREAS said Ordinance abandoned "Crestline Road" from the North line of Morning Glory Drive to the South line of Hollyhock Lane, and from the North line of Hollyhock Lane to the South line of Lake Street;

WHEREAS said Crestline Road was misnamed and misstated in said Ordinance, and the correct name of the street abandoned was part of Hillcrest Avenue from the North line of Morning Glory Drive to the South line of Hollyhock Lane, and from the North line of Hollyhock Lane to the South line of Lake Street and therefore, said Ordinance should be amended to speak the truth of the abandonment.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BULL SHOALS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the following described streets in the City of Bull Shoals, Arkansas should be vacated and abandoned for the reason that said streets and roadways are not required for corporate purposes and have not been open and used by the general public, to-wit:

Hillcrest Avenue from the North line of Morning Glory Drive, South line of Hollyhock Lane, and from the North line of Hollyhock Lane to the South line of Lake Street.

That said abandonment amends Ordinance No. 43 passed and approved February 22, 1972 and said Ordinance should therefore be amended only to the extent of modifying that the portion of street abandoned referenced above was Hillcrest Avenue, not "Crestline Road."

SECTION 2: That there is hereby found and declared to be an immediate need for vacating and abandoning aforesaid roadways; it is, therefore, declared that an emergency exists and this ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare shall be in force and take effect immediately upon and after its passage.
